ANCIENT ROME

Then, wander through the **Roman Forum**, the heart of ancient Rome, and marvel at the ruins of its grand temples and government buildings. Finally, climb **Palatine Hill**, the centermost of Rome's Seven Hills, to enjoy breathtaking views and discover the opulent lifestyles of ancient Rome's elite.



VATICAN CITY



Marvel at **Michelangelo's Pietà** and the grandeur of **St. Peter's Basilica**, one of the world's largest churches, and climb to the dome for a breathtaking view. Explore the **Vatican Museums**, home to countless works of art, including the **Sistine Chapel** with Michelangelo's famous ceiling. Finally, visit **St. Peter's Square** to admire its majestic architecture and perhaps catch a glimpse of the Pope during a Papal Audience.



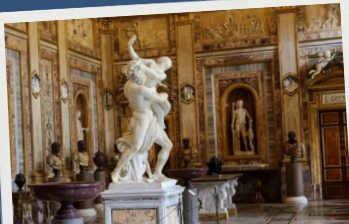
FAMOUS FOUNTAINS

Cap off your cultural journey by attending an enchanting opera or ballet performance at the historic Teatro dell'Opera di Roma.



TOURS AND MORE

Stroll through the enchanting neighborhood of **Trastevere**, where narrow streets, a lively atmosphere, and exceptional dining options await. Then, venture to **Aventine Hill** to experience the tranquil Orange Garden and gaze through the famous keyhole at the Knights of Malta headquarters for a unique view of **St. Peter's Basilica**. For a touch of cinematic history, tour the iconic **Cinecittà Studios**, where countless famous movies have been brought to life.
