



1. Welcome

The Surf Cup International Morocco is an elite international youth football tournament organized by Global Sports Experiences (GSE).

All matches will be played in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game, FRMF regulations, and the provisions outlined in this handbook.

Participation in the tournament implies full acceptance of these regulations.

2. Tournament Venue

All matches will be played in Tangier, Morocco, at FRMF-approved facilities that comply with national federation standards.

3. Age Categories & Formats

Boys Divisions:

- U17 – Born on or after January 1, 2009 (11v11)
- U15 – Born on or after January 1, 2011 (11v11)
- U13 – Born on or after January 1, 2013 (11v11)

Girls Divisions:

- U17 Girls – Born on or after January 1, 2009 (11v11)
- U15 Girls – Born on or after January 1, 2011 (11v11)

Proof of age must be available upon request.



4. Competition Structure

Teams compete in groups of 4 or 5.

Win = 3 points | Draw = 1 point | Loss = 0 points

Top two teams advance to Gold Phase.

Remaining teams advance to Silver Phase.

Knockout matches tied at full time proceed directly to penalties (5 per team, then sudden death).

5. Match Duration

Two halves of 30 minute.

5–10 minute halftime.

No added time.

Strict schedule applies.

6. Substitutions

Unlimited substitutions permitted.

Re-entry allowed in accordance with FRMF youth regulations.

7. Tie-Breaking Criteria

1. Head-to-head
2. Goal difference
3. Goals scored
4. Fewest goals conceded
5. Fair play
6. Drawing of lots



8. Team Rosters & Eligibility

Minimum roster:

- 16 players (11v11)

All players must be properly registered and insured.
Valid passport/ID required.

9. Discipline

2 yellow cards = 1 match suspension.

Straight red card = automatic suspension.

Further sanctions may apply per FRMF disciplinary code.

10. Match Administration

Teams must be present 30 minutes before kickoff.

Second-listed team changes kit in case of color conflict.

Shin guards mandatory.

10-minute delay = possible 3-0 forfeit.

11. Medical & Insurance

First aid available at all venues.

Teams responsible for travel and personal medical insurance.

12. Protests

Written protest required within 30 minutes of match end.

Tournament Committee decisions are final.



13. Force Majeure

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to modify schedules or format due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

14. Authority

The Surf Cup International Morocco Tournament Committee, in coordination with the FRMF, reserves full authority to interpret and enforce these regulations.
